



SCPNA Meeting Minutes for June 1, 2023

1. Introductions
 - a. Everyone went around the room and introduced themselves.
2. Approval of May meeting minutes
 - a. There was motion to approve the meeting minutes from May 2023 and the motion was seconded. It is approved.
3. Mayor's Neighborhood Advocate – Jacob Barnes (Jacob.barnes@indy.gov)
 - a. Arsenal High School's 5K is coming up in September 2023.
 - b. IMPD Teen Academy on June 26 – 30, 2023 (see addendum).
 - c. Brookside Park Pool is open for the summer. The pool is located at 3510 Brookside Parkway South Drive.
 - d. Reminder about the [Summer Concert and Movie Series](#) at various Indianapolis Parks
 - e. Playground renovations in September 2025.
 - f. The [IndyRent Program](#) is now open for 2023. This program is for individuals facing eviction.
 - g. The Clinician-Led Community Response team will be implemented this summer. The teams will respond to 911 calls for non-violent behavior/substance abuse help to help people struggling with mental crises and avoid ending up in the criminal justice systems.
 - h. [Indy Center for Conflict Resolution](#): develop, implement, and evaluate community -based interventions related to conflict resolution and quality-of-life issues. This group will help mediate issues between neighbors, for example.
 - i. [Indy Peacemakers](#) consists of activists from local neighborhoods who provide operational assistance to grassroots neighborhood group with the goal to prevent violence. This group is involved in direct mentoring, coaching, and providing fiscal support for at risk populations.
 - j. The New York and Michigan roadways will be converted to two ways. Both plans are out of the design phase with a projected time for construction to be done end of 2024.
4. IMPD – Steve Talley
 - a. IMPD East District Community Day is July 12th at Brookside Park (3500 Brookside Parkway S Drive) from 11 am to 2 pm. It will be in the shady area of the park this year.
 - b. National Night Out on August 1st: the SCPNA meeting for August will be held on that day at the community space.
5. NEAR Update
 - a. 10th & Rural Streetscaping project/upgrade to start in spring 2024 and will include area from Tecumseh to Rural (east-west), and Rural to St. Clair (north-south).
 - b. The goal is to make 10th Street safer for everyone and will include new lighting, curb bump outs, more greenery, and a multi-use path on the north side of 10th Street.
6. Neighborhood Yard Sale Date Discussion
 - a. The decision was made at the neighborhood meeting to have the neighborhood yard sale on July 15, 2023 to coincide with Raiders of the Lost Antiques.
